## BY-LAW NO. 3644

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of certain sewers as local improvements under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

WHEREAS the Council has by By-law No. 3623 declared that it is desirable to construct sanitary sewers as local improvements in the streets and between the points set out in Schedule "A" thereto.

AND WHEREAS Notice of Intention of the Council to undertake such works was published in the Burnaby Advertiser, a weekly newspaper, published in the District of Burnaby on the 25th day of August, 1955.

AND WHEREAS such Notice of Intention was served on the owners of the lots liable to be specially assessed in the D. L. 117 sewer area as described in such Notice of Intention.

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the Corporation has certified that no sufficient petition against the construction of such works has been presented.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT, subject to the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities, the sewers set out in such Notice of Intention, a true copy of which is attached hereto marked as Schedule "A", be constructed as local improvements under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

2. THAT the Engineer of the District do forthwith make such plans, profiles, and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for making a contract or contracts for the construction of such works. 3. THAT the said works shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.

4. THAT the Reeve and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the construction of the said works to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or firms or corporation or corporations subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by Resolution.

5. THAT the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of such works pending the completion thereof.

6. THAT the Debentures to be issued to pay the cost of such works shall be repayable in twenty annual instalments of principal and shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine in the By-law providing for the issue of the said Debentures.

7. THAT the owners' portion of the cost of such works shall be assessed, levied and collected in the same manner as municipal taxes are assessed, levied and collected upon and from the land in D. L. 117 sewer area as defined in Schedule "A" to this By-law by a special rate re-adjusted and levied from year to year upon the basis of the assessed value of the land within the said D. L. 117 sewer area.

8. THAT the provisions contained in the "Local Improvement Act" relating to the preparation and authentication of a Special Assessment Roll shall not apply to the works to be constructed under the authority of this By-law.

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9. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT D. L. 117 SEWER CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW 1955".

The said Council intends, in the By-law for undertaking the work, to provide that the owner's portion of the cost of such works shall be assessed, levied, and collected in the same manner as municipal tax-s are assessed, levied, and collected upon and from the land in the following defined area (hereinafter called the D.L.117 Sewer Area) by a special rate re-adjusted and levied from year to year during a period of twenty years upon the basis of the assessed value of the land within the said D.L.117 Sewer Area, namely: ALL THOSE DARCELS, lots, and other tracts of land. situate, lying and being in District tota  $165\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $117N_2^1$ , Group 1, New Westminster District, lying within the following described boundaries:


3. The estimated cost of such works is  $\pm 56,855.00$  of which  $\pm 20,118.00$  is to be puid by the Corporation and the balance charged to the D.L.117 Sever Aron as aforementioned.

4. Persona desiring to petition against undertaking the works must do so within one month after the 13th day of August, 1955.

## NOTICE

Under the terms of this proposed Sewer Local Improvement Bylaw, each property within the area outlined on the above sketch will be serviced with one sewer connection to take sanitary wastes from the property.

The pointion of the connection between the building and the property line is the responsibility of each property owner. For the purpose of estimating the property owner's portion of the connection, a rate between \$1.30 to \$1.60 per lineal foot of connection depending upon depths, would be reasonable. If the property owner chooses, he may install the connection himself and may obtain information at the office of the Building Inspector.

The cost of the sewer and house connection to the property owners with average sized residential lots will average approximately \$9.00 per year for 20 years. However, this figure will vary widely depending entirely on the assessed value of the land for the various properties.

The larger industrial type properties will pay a somewhat larger charge depending upon their land assessed value.
