

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3646

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1558, being the
"Burnaby Fire Prevention By-law 1936".

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District
of Burnaby in open meeting assembled ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1558 is amended by adding the following as
Section 11A.

"11.A. No person shall fire or set off any fire-ball, squib,
cracker, or other fireworks in or on any street, lane, square,
park or other public place without having first obtained from
the Fire Chief a permit in writing so to do."

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION
BY-LAW 1936, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1955".
