BY-LAW NO. 3659

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of certain waterworks and the expenditure therefor of part of the moneys borrowed under authority of By-laws 3082 and 3409 for other purposes.

WHEREAS By-law No. 3082 of the Corporation, being the "Burnaby Waterworks Loan By-law 1950", authorized the construction of the certain waterworks defined therein and the borrowing of \$892,000.00 therefor by the issue and sale of debentures.

AND WHEREAS the said waterworks have been constructed and there remains unexpended the sum of \$2,352.18 in the said By-law No. 3082 fund.

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 3409 of the Corporation, being the "Burnaby Waterworks Loan By-law 1953", authorized the construction of the certain waterworks defined therein and the borrowing of \$1,220,000.00 therefor by the issue and sale of debentures.

AND WHEREAS the said waterworks have been constructed save and except certain projects which are now deemed to be unnecessary.

AND WHEREAS there remains unexpended the sum of \$204,349.82 in the said By-law No. 3409 fund.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the public interest to replace, renew, repair and improve the existing main water supply line serving the central low pressure area of the Municipality as hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered from time to time as such work in the opinion of Council becomes necessary, to replace, renew, repair and improve the existing main water supply line serving the central low pressure area

of the Municipality along the route described as:

Edinburgh Street from Ingleton Avenue to Gilmore Avenue, south on Gilmore Avenue to Trinity Street, east on Trinity Street to Carlton Avenue, south on Carlton Avenue to Cambridge Street, east on Cambridge Street to Willingdon Avenue, south on Willingdon Avenue to Grandview Highway, east on Grandview Highway to Royal Oak Avenue, south on Royal Oak Avenue to Grassmere Street.

- 2. The Municipal Council is further authorized and empowered to expend for such purposes the sum of \$2,352.18, being the unexpended balance in the By-law No. 3082 fund, and the sum of \$204,349.82, being the unexpended balance in the By-law No. 3409 fund.
- 3. This By-law shall, before the final passage thereof, receive the assent of the electors of the Municipality in the manner provided in the Municipal Act.
- 4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY WATERWORKS CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW 1955".
