THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3703

A BY-LAW to authorize the Municipal Council to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes and to give in exchange therefor certain tax-sale lands of the Municipality.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby in open meeting assembled ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire for road widening purposes by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances those lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the South Thirty-three (33) feet of Blocks Thirty-seven (37) and Thirtyeight (38) of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-nine (129), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 1492.

2. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be and become dedicated as a highway for the free use of the public in all times hereafter.

3. The Municipal Council is further authorized and empowered to give in exchange for the said lands to the owner thereof or to his nominee those lands which have become the property of the Municipality through tax-sale proceedings and are more particularly known and described as the South Sixty (60') feet of Lot Ten (10) of Blocks Thirty-nine (39) to Forty-three (43), of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-nine (129), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 16096.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROPERTY EXCHANGE AND ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW 1956".
