BY-LAW NO. 3709

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain municipally-owned lands for highway purposes.

WHEREAS the Municipality of the District of Burnaby is the owner in fee simple of those lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly hereinafter described.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to dedicate the said lands for highway purposes.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the lands hereinafter described are hereby dedicated as a highway to and for the free use of the public in all time hereafter.
- (a) Lot "A", Block Thirty (30), District Lot Fifty-three (53), Group One (1), of New Westminster according to Plan No. 3037 deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.
- (b) Lot "A", save and except the easterly Two hundred and seventy-seven (277') feet thereof, Block Twenty-one (21), District Lot Fifty-three (53), Group One (1), New Westminster District, according to Plan No. 3037 deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster aforesaid.
- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1956".
