## BY-LAW NO. 3710

A BY-LAW to provide for borrowing $629,232.60$ upon debentures to pay for the construction of certain asphaltic pavements within the Municipality.

WHEREAS pursuant to the construction by-laws more particularly designated in Column 1 of Schedule "A" hereof, the Corporation has constructed certain asphaltic pavements upon those streets within the Municipality more particularly described in Colum 2 of the said Schedule "A" as local improvenents under the provisions of the Local Improvenent Act.

AND WHEREAS the total cost of the said works is $457,502.17$ of which $\$ 17,258.98$ is the Corporation's portion of the cost and $446,243.19$ is the owners' portion of the cost for which special assessment rolls have been duly made and certified.

AND WHEREAS '17,010.59 of the owners' portion of the cost has been paid in cash prior to the passage of this By-law, thereby reducing the owners' portion of the cost for the purpose of this By-lew to $29,232.60$.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation's portion of the cost has been paid by the Corporation in cash.

AND WHEREAS the estimated lifetine of the said works is ten years.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to borrow the owners' portion of the cost remaining unpaid, being the sum of $\$ 29,232.60$ on the credit of the Corporation, and to issue debentures therefor bearing interest at the rate of four ( $4 \%$ ) per centum per amum, which is the amount of the debt intended to be created by this By-law.

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AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make the principal of the said debt repayoble in yearly sums during the period of two years, of such amounts respectively that the aggregate amount payable for principal end interest in any year shall be equal as nearly as may be to the amount so payable for principal and interest in each of the other years.

AND WHEREAS it will be necessary to raise annually the sum of $15,524.87$ during the period of two years to pay the said yearly sums of principal and interest as they becone due.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality gccoriing to the last revised assessnent roll, beins the assessmeat roll for the year 1956, is ${ }^{\text {sin }} 146,021,638.00$.

AND WHEREAS the anount of the existing debenture debt of the Corporation (exclusive of local improvement deots, secured by special rates or assessments) is $6,530,603.52$, and no part of the principal or interest is in arrear.

THEREPORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Eurneby ENACTS as follows:

1. That for the purpose aforesaid there shall be borrowed on the creait of the Corporation at large the sum of Twentynine thousand, two hundred and thirty-two dollars and sixty cents ( $29,232.60$ ) and debentures shall be issued therefor in sums of not less than one hundred dollars ( ${ }^{(100.00}$ ) each, bearing interest at the rate of four ( $4 \%$ ) per centun per anum, and having coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest.
2. The said debentures shall be dated the second (2nd) day of Januery, 1956, and shall be payable on the second (2nd) day of Januery in the respective years and in the
respective amounts as hereunder:

3. The said debentures shall be payable, according to the tenor thereof, at the principal office of The Royal Bank of Canada in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of Bxitish Columbia.
4. The Reeve of the Corporation shall sign the debentures and interest coupons, and the sane shall also be signed by the Treasurer of the Corporation, but the signatures on the coupons may be lithographed and the debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation.
5. During two yeara, the currency of the debentures, the sum of $15,524.87$ shall be raised annually for the payment of the debt and the interest as follows:

For the payment of the owners' portion of the cost and the interest thereon, the special assessment set forth In the said special assessaent rolls prepared pursuant to the Construction By-laws set out in Column 1 of Schedule "A" attached hereto and hereb incorporated with this By-law, is hereby imposed upon the lands liable therefor as therein set Corth; which said special assessnent, with a sum sufficient to cover interest thereon at the rate aforesaid, shall be payable in two equal amual instalments of $415,524.87$ each, and for that purpose an equal annual special rate of 42.5 cents pex foot frontege is hereby imposed upon each lot entered in the said special assessment roll, according to the assessed frontage thereof, over and above all other rates and taxes, which said special rate shall be collected
anomaly by the Collector of Taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same namer as other rates. 6. This Bylaw shall take effect and cone into force upon the registration thereof.
7. This Ey-law may be cited as "BUBNABY LOCAL IMPROVEUET DEBETTURE BY-LAW NO. 1, 1956".
