

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3728

A BY-LAW to authorize a grant of \$15,000.00 to the Board of Park Commissioners out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 537 of the "Municipal Act" for the construction of an underpass across the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way in District Lot 215, Group 1, New Westminster District.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby has by By-law set aside all moneys received from the sale of tax-sale properties.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside are deposited in a special account in The Royal Bank of Canada at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia or have been invested in the manner provided in Section 212 of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and any interest earned thereon may be used for expenditures of a capital or other special nature.

AND WHEREAS sinking funds on hand are equal to or greater than requirements.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and interest earned thereon amounted on the Eighteenth (18th) day of June, 1956 to Three Hundred and Ninety-five Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-two Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$395,892.11)

AND WHEREAS the Board of Park Commissioners of the said District deems it expedient and in the public interest to develop a public park and recreation ground upon Lots Three (3) and Four (4), District Lot Two Hundred and Fifteen (215), Group One (1) New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS the said Lots Three (3) and Four (4) are separated by the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way.

AND WHEREAS the Board of Transport Commissioners has ordered that an underpass be constructed to provide access from the said Lot Three (3) to the said Lot Four (4) across the said right-of-way.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to make a grant of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) to the Board of Park Commissioners of the said District out of the tax-sale moneys set aside as aforesaid, and interest thereon, for the purpose of constructing the said underpass.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to grant unto the Board of Park Commissioners of the said District the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) of moneys received from the sale of tax-sale properties and interest thereon and set aside as aforesaid, for the construction of an underpass across the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way from Lot Three (3) to Lot Four (4), of District Lot Two Hundred and Fifteen (215), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 3082.
2. The Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to do all necessary acts and things to withdraw and expend the said sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the purpose herein specified.
3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX-SALE LANDS MONEYS EXPENDITURE BY-LAW NO. 5, 1956"

vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council
this Ninth (9th) day of July , 1956.
