THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3728

A BY-LAW to authorize a grant of \$15,000.00 to the Board of Park Commissioners out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 537 of the "Municipal Act" for the construction of an underpass across the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way in District Lot 215, Group 1, New Westminster District.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby has by By-law set aside all moneys received from the sale of tax-sale properties.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside are deposited in a special account in The Royal Bank of Canada at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia or have been invested in the manner provided in Section 212 of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and any interest earned thereon may be used for expenditures of a capital or other special nature.

AND WHEREAS sinking funds on hand are equal to or greater than requirements.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and interest earned thereon amounted on the Eighteenth (18th) day of June, 1956 to Three Hundred and Ninety-five Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-two Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$395,892.11)

AND WHEREAS the Board of Park Commissioners of the said District deems it expedient and in the public interest to develop a public park and recreation ground upon Lots Three (3) and Four (4), District Lot Two Hundred and Fifteen (215), Group One (1) New Westminster District.

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council this Ninth (9th) day of July , 1956.

RECEIVED the Approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council this Twenty-ninth (29th) day of June , 1956.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council this Sixteenth (16th) day of July , 1956.
