BY-LAW NO. 3744

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands for highway purposes.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may pass By-laws for

acquiring lands from any person for and to the use of the Municipality.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from Margary Eileen Otto by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, for the extension of Grange Street, those lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as Lot Three (3), Block Fifty-one (51), District Lot Thirty-three (33), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 1316, paying therefor the sum of Ten Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$10,100.00).
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1956".
