

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3759

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from British Columbia Electric Company Limited by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot "B", Block Nineteen (19) of Lot Fifty-three (53), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 3371, COMMENCING at the northerly corner of Lot "B", as same is shown on Plan No. 3371 deposited; thence S. $39^{\circ}33'$ East, along the easterly boundary of Lot "B", 279.2 feet, more or less, to the southeasterly corner thereof; thence S. $50^{\circ}33'30''$ West, along the southerly boundary of Lot "B", 66 feet; thence N. $39^{\circ}33'$ West, and parallel to the easterly boundary of Lot "B", 145.58 feet; thence N. $15^{\circ}26'20''$ West, 146.28 feet, more or less, to the intersection with the northerly boundary of Lot "B"; thence N. $50^{\circ}33'30''$ East, along the northerly boundary of Lot "B", 6.25 feet, more or less to the point of commencement; said parcel containing 0.33 acres, more or less as shown outlined in red on the plan prepared by C. D. Underhill, B. C. L. S., dated the 23rd day of August, 1956, and filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.

2. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the said Land Registry Office, the said lands shall be dedicated as and become a highway for the free use of the public in all times hereafter.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 8, 1956".
