THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3765

A BY-LAW to authorize the Municipal Council to dispose of lands which have become the property of the Municipality through tax-sale proceedings and accept as part payment therefor other lands in the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council, may by a by-law finally passed by an affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4) of all the members, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, dispose of lands which have become the property of the Municipality through tax-sale proceedings and accept as full or part payment therefor other lands in the Municipality.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the l. District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to convey to Spani & Sons Construction Co. Ltd., a body corporate having a registered office at 3091 Irving Street in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances those tax-sale lands more particularly described as Lots Twentyfive (25) and Twenty-Six (26), Block Seven (7), District Lot One Hundred and Fifty-nine (159), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 16893, and to accept from the said Company in payment therefor the sum of Sixteen Hundred Dollars (\$1600.00) as well as a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances of those lands situate in the said municipality and more particularly known and described as Lot One (1), Block Thirty (30) of Lot Twenty-seven (27), Group One (1) Plan 697 save and except part subdivided by Plan 14074, save and except part subdivided by Flan 16183 and save and except part subdivided by Plan 16882, New Westminster District.

This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROPERTY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 2, 1956."
