A BY-LAW to authorize the granting of an easement to the British Columbia Electric Company Limited.

- 1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered, by and with the consent of any encumbrancers of the said lands, to grant unto the British Columbia Electric Company Limited for good and valuable consideration an easement or right-of-way for overhead transmission lines over those portions of Lot Six (6) and Lot Ten (10), Group One (1), New West-minster District, Plan 10438 as shown outlined in red on the plan hereto attached prepared by David H. Burnett, B.C.L.S., and dated the Fifteenth (15th) day of October, 1956.
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BRITISH COLUMBIA ELECTRIC COMPANY LIMITED EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1956."
