## BY-LAW NO. 3788

A BY-LAW to authorize the Municipal Council to acquire certain lands and to grant and convey the said lands in exchange for other lands required for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the North 464.81 feet of Lot One (1), (save and except part shown on Explanatory Plan No. 12900), Block Nineteen (19), District Lot Six (6), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan No. 6105, paying therefor the sum of Seventeen Hundred (\$1700.00) Dollars.

2. The Municipal Council is further authorized and empowered upon acquiring the said lands and premises as aforesaid to grant and convey the same unto The Director, The Veterans' Land Act and to acquire from the said Director in exchange therefor for highway purposes by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby aforesaid and more particularly known and described as all that portion of Lot One (1), Block Nineteen (19), District Lot Six (6), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Explanatory Plan 12900 commencing at the North-West corner of said Lot One (1); thence S 89° 31' E along the Northeast corner of said Lot One (1); thence S 0° 51' E along the Easterly boundary of said Lot One (1), 3.93 feet more or less to an iron post; thence S 46° 51' W, 222.84 feet more or less to an intersection with the Westerly boundary of said Lot One (1); thence N 0° 55' 30" W along the Westerly boundary of said Lot One (1), 157.72 feet more or less to point of commencement; containing 0.31 acres more or less.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROPERTY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 3, 1956."
