

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3793

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands for and to the use of the municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by By-law acquire lands from any person for and to the use of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances for and to the use of the municipality and paying therefor the sum of Thirty-four Hundred (\$3400.00) Dollars those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia more particularly known and described as Lot Thirty-seven (37) of Lot "C", Block Five (5) of the Northerly part of Lot Ninety-four (94), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 15393.
2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1957."
