THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3795

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands within the Municipality and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple free and clear of all encumbrances in consideration of the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the West Four (4') feet of the West half (W.½) of Lot Four (4), Block Seventy-eight (78) of Lot Thirty-three (33), Group One (1), New Westminster District, according to Plan No. 5074 deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
- 2. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the said Land Registry Office, the said lands shall be dedicated as and become a highway for the free use of the public in all times hereafter.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1957."
