THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3803

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain easements for and to the use of the municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by By-law acquire easements from any person for and to the use of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows;

- 1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire easements for and to the use of the municipality through, under and across those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby in the Province of British Columbia more particularly known and described as:
- (a) The West Ten (10') feet of Lot Six (6), Block Twenty-four (24), Lot Thirty-four (34), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan No. 17237.
- (b) The West Ten (10') feet of Lot Five (5), Block Twenty-four (24), Lot Thirty-four (34), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan No. 17237.
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1957."
