THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3836

A BY-LAW to authorize the purchase of certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law purchase lands from any person for and to the use of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase and acquire by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple for road purposes those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as Lot Twelve (12), Block Six (6) of Lot Thirty-two (32), Group One (1), Plan 2278, New Westminster District, from Conrad Albert Anderson and Verona Anderson, Joint Tenants, the registered owners thereof, paying therefor the sum of Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred and Thirty-five (\$9,735.00) Dollars.
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 3. 1957."
