

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3844

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire property within the Municipality and to dedicate the same for park purposes.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to acquire the hereinafter described lands and to dedicate the same for park purposes.

AND WHEREAS the said hereinafter described lands are owned by Ellen Jessie Fraser.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from Ellen Jessie Fraser by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand (\$11,000.00) Dollars All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby in the Province of British Columbia more particularly known and described as Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10) of Lot Eighty-five (85), Group One (1), Plan 3322, New Westminster District.
2. Upon Registration of the said deed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminister, in the Province of British Columbia the said lands and premises shall be deemed to be and are hereby established and set aside as a public park to and for the free use of the public for all time thereafter.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION AND PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1957."
