

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3855

A BY-LAW to exempt certain trades and businesses from the provisions of sections 866 and 867 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 42 of the Statutes of 1957.

WHEREAS pursuant to section 869 of the Municipal Act, Council may by by-law, with the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, exempt completely, or to such extent as may be specified in the by-law, any of the trades and businesses therein specified from the provisions of sections 866 and 867 of the Municipal Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council does hereby exempt completely during the whole year the following trades and businesses from the provisions of sections 866 and 867 of the Municipal Act, namely; Automobile service-stations, service-garages or garages, bakeries, drug-stores, or stands within a shop for the sale of fresh fruits, fresh vegetables, soft drinks, dairy products, bakery products, cut flowers, florists' products, and confectionery.
2. This By-law shall take effect and come into force on the first day of July, 1957.
3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SHOPS REGULATION EXEMPTION BY-LAW 1957."
