THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3856

A BY-LAW to provide an annual indemnity for the Reeve and Councillors.

WHEREAS the Council of a municipality having a population of more than 50,000 may by by-law provide for paying out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Reeve not exceeding \$7,500 and to each Councillor not exceeding \$2,500.

AND WHEREAS such by-law may provide that a portion of the remuneration to be paid to the Reeve or to a Councillor shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

AND WHEREAS the District of Burnaby has a population exceeding 50,000.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. There shall be paid to the Reeve out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$7,500 and one-third of such indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.
- 2. There shall be paid to each Councillor out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$2,500 and one-third of such indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.
- 3. By-law No. 690 is repealed.
- 4. This By-law shall take effect and come into force on the first day of July 1957.
- 5. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INDEMNITY BY-LAW 1957."
