A BY-LAW to regulate the closing of shops  
within the municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law,  
pursuant to section 867 of the Municipal Act, being  
Chapter 42 of the Statutes of 1957, regulate the  
closing of shops within the municipality to the extent  
therein provided.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corpora-  
tion of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subject to section 869 of the Municipal Act,  
all shops shall be closed for the serving of customers  
in each week of the year:-

(a) On Monday, not later than twelve o'clock  
noon, except during the months of July and August when  
all shops shall be closed for the serving of customers  
not later than six o'clock in the afternoon;

(b) On Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday,  
not later than six o'clock in the afternoon;

(c) On Friday, not later than nine o'clock in  
the afternoon.

2. This By-law shall take effect and come into force  
on the first day of July, 1957.

3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any  
of the provisions of this By-law shall be liable to a fine  
not exceeding one hundred dollars or, in default, to  
imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SHOPS CLOSING  
BY-LAW 1957."
