

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3865

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 3477 being the  
"Burnaby Street and Traffic By-law  
1954."

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Clause Three (3) is amended by the addition thereto  
of the following:

"SPECIAL CONSTABLE shall mean any person or persons  
employed by the Municipality as a parking and pedestrian  
control officer."

2. Section Twenty-seven (27) is repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:

"27. Except as otherwise provided no person shall stop  
or park a vehicle in the areas set forth in the Motor-vehicle  
Act or in the areas set forth in Schedule "B" hereto under  
the heading "Parking Restrictions (General)" and shall not  
park in any street or portion of a street set forth in Schedule  
"B" hereto under the headings "One Hour Parking Areas" and  
"Fifteen Minute Parking Areas" for a longer period of time than  
that indicated on any traffic sign applicable to that portion of  
the street where such a vehicle is parked; provided, however,  
that the restrictions imposed under the headings "One Hour  
Parking Areas" and "Fifteen Minute Parking Areas" shall not apply  
on statutory holidays, Sundays, Mondays or such day as is  
designated by Council for the general closing of shops, or on  
any other day of the week between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and  
9:00 a.m."

3. Section Twenty-eight (28) is repealed and the following  
substituted therefor:

"28. The Council may by resolution provide for the appoint-  
ment of one or more Special Constables whose duty it shall be  
under the direction of the Officer-in-charge of the Traffic

Division, Burnaby Detachment of The Royal Canadian Mounted Police, to enforce the provisions of this By-law relating to restrictions upon parking of vehicles, and regulation of pedestrian traffic, and the Council may make such provision as to the duties and for the remuneration of such Special Constables as the Council may deem advisable.

4. Section One Hundred and Twenty-two (122) is amended by the insertion after the figures "\$250.00" and before the word "together" in the first paragraph thereof the following:

"Provided that in respect of parking and pedestrian traffic violations the penalties therefor shall be the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty (\$2.50) Cents for overtime parking in an area wherein parking is restricted and Five (\$5.00) Dollars for pedestrian violations,"

5. Schedule " B" of Section Twenty-eight (28) is amended

(1) By adding under the section headed "One Hour Parking Areas" the following:

"Kingsway - North side between Patterson Avenue and Boundary Road."

(2) By adding under the section headed "Fifteen Minute Parking Areas" the following:

"Kingsway - North side from a point One Hundred and Four (104') feet West of the West property line to Sussex Avenue to a point One Hundred and Fifty-four (154') feet West thereof, being a distance of Fifty (50') feet."

6. This By-law shall take effect and come into force upon the final passage thereof by the Municipal Council.

7. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 1954, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1957."
