BY-LAW NO. 3867

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 540 being the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926."

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 540 is amended by striking out Section
 Twenty-eight (28) and substituting therefor the following:
- "28. (1) No person shall occupy or cause to be occupied any building until he has received a Certificate of Occupancy from the Building Inspector. The Building Inspector, before issuing such Certificate shall satisfy himself that all necessary permits have been issued and relevant inspections made, and that such building and all parts thereof and all materials used therein have been constructed and installed, erected and completed in full compliance with the provisions of this By-law, and any other applicable by-law or statute.
- (2). No Certificate of Occupancy shall be granted until such time as the exterior finish of such building shall have been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by the Building Inspector at the time of application for a building permit, or as altered with the approval of the Building Inspector. Provided that appeal shall lie to the Municipal Council by any person claiming that owing to special circumstances the literal enforcement of this provision would result in unnecessary hardship."
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1926, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1957."
