

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3872

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1825 being the
"Burnaby Procedure By-law 1944."

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY PROCEDURE BY-LAW 1944, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1957."
2. By-law No. 1825 is amended by striking out sections 38 to 44 inclusive and substituting therefor the following:

"38. Every by-law shall be introduced upon motion for leave, specifying its title or intended object.

39. Every by-law shall receive three readings. If a majority of the Council then present object to a second or third reading thereof on one day, the by-law shall not have a further reading on that day.

40. A by-law shall be deemed to be read when its title is read, but if a majority of the Council then present require it, the whole of the by-law shall be read clause by clause.

41. Every by-law passed by the Council shall be reconsidered not less than one day after the by-law has received third reading, and, if adopted by the Council, shall be signed by the Reeve or other member of the Council presiding at the meeting at which the by-law has been adopted, and shall be signed by the Clerk who shall affix thereto the corporate seal of the Municipality.

42. The following motions shall be used when dealing with a by-law:

(1) Motion that leave be given to introduce the by-law and that it be now read a first time.

(2) Motion that the by-law be now read a second time.

(3) Motion that the Council go into Committee of the Whole to consider and report on the by-law.

(4) Motion that the Committee rise and report.

(5) Motion that the Committee's report be adopted.

(6) Motion that the by-law be read a third time.

(7) Motion that the by-law be now reconsidered and adopted and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the By-law.

43. The motion, "That leave be given to introduce the by-law and that it be now read a first time," shall be decided without amendment or debate.

44. A copy of every by-law, signed by the Reeve and Clerk and duly sealed, shall be filed by the Clerk in his office."
