THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3890

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain real property for and to the use of the Municipality for municipal purposes.

WHEREAS the Council may by by-law, subject to the restrictions in the Municipal Act contained, acquire by purchase, gift, lease, or otherwise any real property and rights, easements or privileges in and to real property from Canada or the Province for and to the use of the municipality for municipal purposes.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISI-TION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1957."
- 2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered for the purpose of diverting Royal Oak Avenue to acquire by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple from the registered owners thereof, paying therefor the sum of \$15,800.00, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as: Lots 6 and 7 of the North Portion of Lot 74, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan No. 3782.
