BY-LAW NO. 3895

A BY-LAW to impose on the occupants or owners of lands within the municipality the duty of destroying noxious weeds and weed-seeds on portions of road adjoining such lands.

WHEREAS the Council of any municipality may by by-law provide that the occupant or owner upon whom the duty is imposed under section 4 of the "Noxious Weeds Act" to destroy the noxious weeds and weed-seeds on any land within the municipality shall also destroy noxious weeds and weed-seeds on that portion of any road which adjoins that land lying between the boundary of that land and the middle line of the road; and thereupon every occupant or owner within the scope of the by-law shall for all purposes of Part I of the said Act be deemed to be the occupant or owner of that portion of every road which so adjoins his land.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY NOXIOUS WEEDS BY-LAW 1957."
2. All words defined in the "Noxious Weeds Act" shall have the same meaning in this by-law unless the context otherwise requires.
3. The occupant or owner upon whom the duty is imposed under section 4 of the "Noxious Weeds Act" to destroy the noxious weeds and weed-seeds on any land within the municipality shall also destroy all noxious weeds and weed-seeds on that portion of any road which adjoins that land lying between the boundary of that land and the middle line of the road.

4. Such occupant or owner shall destroy the noxious weeds and weed-seeds upon the aforesaid portion of road whenever the inspector shall notify him in writing and within the time stated in the notice.

5. Every person to whom such notice is given who fails to destroy the noxious weeds and weed-seeds as required by the notice shall be guilty of an offence against this by-law and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than five dollars and not more than fifty dollars.
