THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3898

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain municipally owned lands.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law sell by auction or otherwise any real property which is owned by the Municipality and no longer required for municipal or other public purposes and which is free from any reservation or dedication.

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is no longer required for municipal purposes and is free from any reservation or dedication.

AND WHEREAS The Board of School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) wishes to acquire the said property as the site of an administration building.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 13, 1957."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to grant and convey unto The Board of School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, for the purposes aforesaid those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as Lots 13, 14 and 15, of part of the north half of Lot 80, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 10063.
