BY-LAW NO. 3946

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain municipally owned lands.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 5, 1958."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to grant and convey unto Samuel Edmund Hughes by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars payable upon delivery of the said deed and subject to consolidation with Lot "A" of Block 16, of Lot 161, Group 1, Plan 13299, New Westminster District, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as the westerly 41.6 feet of Lot 6, of Block 16, of the northerly part of Lot 161, Group 1, Plan 1742, New Westminster District, being measured at right angles to the westerly boundary thereof.
3. The Municipal Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey unto Irene Thea Pelzer and Richard Arthur Pelzer by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand, Two Hundred (\$2,200.00) Dollars payable upon delivery of the said deed, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as Lot 30, Blocks 1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14, District Lot 11, Group 1, Plan 16871, New Westminster District.
