

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3951

A BY-LAW to regulate the closing of shops within the municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law, pursuant to Division (3) of Part XVIII of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 42 of the Statutes of British Columbia 1957, regulate the closing of shops within the municipality to the extent therein provided.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SHOPS REGULATION BY-LAW 1958."
2. All shops, as defined by section 865 of the Municipal Act,
 - (a) shall be closed and remain closed for the serving of customers
 - (i) On Monday, not later than twelve o'clock noon;
 - (ii) On Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday, not later than six o'clock in the afternoon;
 - (iii) On Friday, not later than nine o'clock in the afternoon; but notwithstanding
 - (b) may remain open for the serving of customers until the hour of nine o'clock in the afternoon on any or all of the seven business-days immediately preceding Christmas Day or on the day immediately preceding a day specified in section 866 of the Municipal Act.
3. The Licence Inspector shall issue a permit granting exemption from the provisions of section 869 B of the Municipal Act to any operator of an automobile service-station, or of an

automobile service-garage , who may apply therefor in writing, said permit to be valid up to and including the 30th day of June 1958.

4. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or in default to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

5. By-law No. 3855 and By-law No. 3858 are repealed.


