## BYLAW NO. 3962

A BY-LAW to amend Bylaw No. 3884 being the "Burnaby District Improvement Bylaw No. 2, $1957^{\prime \prime}$.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council reconsidered and adopted Bylaw No. 3884 on the Fth day of October 1957 after the said Bylaw had received the assent of the owner-electors within the Gilmore Sanitary Sewer Area, defined in the said By-law, on the 28 th day of September, 1957.


#### Abstract

AND WHEREAS the said Bylaw authorized the construction of certain sanitary sewers (hereinafter celled "the said works") and provided that the entire cost of the said works be levied and raised by rate upon the "real property subject to taxation for municipal purposes within the said Gilmore Sanitary Sewer Area".


AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council intended that the entire cost of the said works be levied and raised by rate upon the "lands" only within the said Gilmore Sanitary Sewer Area.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY DISTRTOT ImPROVEMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1957, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1958".
2. Section 6 of By-lew No. 3884 is amended by striking out the words "real property" in the second line and substituting "lands".
3. This Bylaw shall beßeemed to have come into force on the last day of January 1958 and is retroactive to the extent necessary to give effect to the provisions hereof.
