BY-LAW NO. 3972.

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of Portland cement concrete sidewalks five feet wide with curb on sundry streets as a local improvement under the provisions of Part XVI of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council to undertake the construction, as a local improvement, of the works hereinafter described has been duly given by publication of the notice and by service of it upon the owners of the parcels liable to be specially charged.

AND WHEREAS publication and service of such notice has been proved by a statutory declaration filed by the Clerk.

AND WHEREAS no petition against the said works, signed by a majority of the owners, representing at least one-half of the land value of the parcels which are liable to be specially charged, has been presented.

AND WHEREAS the Council has had prepared in respect of the said works the report hereunto annexed and marked as Schedule "A".

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1958".
- 2. That Portland cement sidewalks five (5') feet wide with curb be constructed on the streets hereinafter described under the provisions of Part XVI of the Municipal Act.
- (a) West side of Springer Avenue from Parker Street to Lougheed Highway.

SCHEDULE "F"

BY-LAW NO. 3972

- 1. Pursuant to By-law No. 3972, adopted on the 14th day of July, 1958, Portland cement sidewalks, five feet wide, have been constructed on the streets hereinafter described:-
 - (1). West side of Springer Avenue from Parker Street to Lougheed Highway.
 - (2). West side of Springer Avenue from Hastings Street to Parker Street.
 - (3). West side of North Road from Lyndhurst Street to Lougheed Highway.
 - (4). South side of 12th Avenue from 6th Street to Cumberland Street.
- 2. The total cost of constructing the sidewalks is \$44,009.59; the Corporation's share is nil; the owners' share is \$44,009.59.
- 3. The estimated lifetime of the said works is twenty years.
