THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3978

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain municipally-owned lands.

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described are no longer required for municipal or other public purposes and are not reserved or dedicated.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW 1. NO. 11, 1958".

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District 2. of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to sell unto The First Christian Reformed Church of New Westminster, B. C., those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as Parcels "G" and "H", of Lot 25, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 19120, in consideration of the sum of \$2,300.00, payable \$600.00 upon the execution and delivery of the agreement for sale of the said lands and the balance in three equal annual instalments with interest at six per centum per annum, and in further consideration of the dedication by the said Purchaser as a public highway for the extension of 13th Avenue of those portions of Lots 2 and 3, Block 2, of Lot 25, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1024, shown outlined in red on the said Plan 19120, and each containing by admeasurement 0.175 acres more or less.
