THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3983

A BY-LAW to reserve certain municipally-owned lands for park purposes.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is the owner in fee simple of those lands hereinafter described.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law reserve for a particular municipal or other public purpose any land owned by the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it in the public interest to reserve the lands hereinafter described for park purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK RESERVATION BY-LAW 1958".

2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby does hereby reserve for park purposes those municipallyowned lands more particularly known and described as Lots 1 to 8 inclusive and Lot "A" of Block "D" of part of Block "A" of the center portion of Lot 28, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plans 1078 and 10412, save and except those portions of the said lands now road, shown outlined in red on the plan prepared by Geoffrey K. Burnett, B. C. L. S., dated the 2nd day of August, 1952 and deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia with By-law No. 3252 under filing number 36092. Read a first time this 25th day of August, 1958. Read a second time this 25th day of August, 1958. Read a third time this 25th day of August, 1958. Reconsidered and adopted this 8th day of September
