THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3988

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands within the Municipality and dedicate the same for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1958".
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), those lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as the north 20 feet of the south 130 feet of Lot "K", Block 49 of Lot 35, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to a registered map or plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, and numbered 799, said south 130 feet having a frontage of 130 feet on Smith Avenue and adjoining Lot "A" to "J" of said Block 49, the northeast corner of said south 130 feet being also the northwest corner of said Lot "A".
3. Upon registration of the said deed in the Land Registry Office aforesaid, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
