

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3996

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1515 being the "Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound By-law 1935".

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND BY-LAW 1935, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1958".
2. Section 4 of By-law No. 1515 as enacted by By-law No. 1921 is repealed and the following substituted:
"4. Every such person shall pay to the Collector a license fee of two **dollars** for each male dog and of five dollars for each female dog."
3. Section 21 as enacted by By-law No. 3201 is repealed and the following substituted
"21. Subject to section 20, the owner of any impounded dog may reclaim it from the pound keeper
 - (a) upon paying the sum of four dollars, if he had paid the current license fee before the dog was impounded; and
 - (b) upon payment of six dollars if he had not so paid the current license fee.
4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 2nd day of January, 1959.
