BY-LAW NO. 4000

A BY-LAW to provide for obtaining by referendum the opinion of the electors of the municipality upon the question of fluoridation of the communal water supply.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may by by-law provide for obtaining by referendum, at the time of the annual elections, the opinion of the electors, upon any question which affects the municipality and with which the Council has power to deal.

AND WHEREAS, subject to the provisions of the Health Act, the Municipal Council may undertake such measures as are deemed necessary for the preservation of public health and the maintenance of sanitary conditions in the municipality, including the chlorination and fluoridation of the water supply.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FLUORIDATION REFERENDUM BY-LAW 1958".
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to obtain by referendum at the annual elections on the 11th day of December, 1958, the opinion of the electors upon the following question, namely, "Do you favour fluoridation of the communal water supply?"

Read a firsttime this 3rd day of November, 1958.

Read a second time this 3rd day of November, 1958.

Read a third time this 3rd day of November, 1958.

Reconsidered and adopted this 10th day of November,
1958.
