THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4001

A BY-LAW to establish a joint Parks and Recreation Commission.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council did by By-law No. 3926 establish a Parks Commission and by By-law No. 3925 did establish a Recreation Commission.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 632-A of the Municipal Act the Municipal Council of a district municipality may by by-law, instead of establishing a Recreation Commission, empower the Parks Commission to undertake the functions of a Recreation Commission.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it desirable and in the public interest to repeal By-law No. 3925 and to establish a joint Parks and Recreation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION BY-LAW 1958."
2. The Parks Commission is hereby authorized and empowered
  - (a) to organize and conduct a recreation programme in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Council of Public Instruction; and
  - (b) to expend moneys for the purpose aforesaid within the amount appropriated therefor by the Council; and
  - (c) to expend other moneys lawfully received by the Commission for the purpose aforesaid.
3. The Parks Commission shall, upon and after the adoption of this By-law, be known as the Parks and Recreation Commission.

4. By-law No. 3925 is repealed.
