BY-LAW NO. 4009

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1825 being the "Burnaby Procedure By-law 1944".

WHEREAS notice in writing of this by-law has been duly given and openly announced at a regular meeting of the Municipal Council held on the 3rd day of November, 1958.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby **RESOLVES** as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROCEDURE BY-LAW 1944, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1958".
2. By-law No. 1825 is amended by adding the following as section 43 A:
 "43 A. If a majority of the Council then present agree, two or more by-laws may together be given three readings and may together be reconsidered and adopted."

Read a third time this 17th day of November, 1958.
