BY-LAW NO. 4018

A BY-LAW to authorize the Council to abate or rebate current taxes and rates pursuant to section 411 of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS the Council may, pursuant to section 411 of the Municipal Act, by by-law extend the period for payment of or abate or rebate any taxes, rates, or local improvement assessments or any part thereof assessed, levied or imposed upon the property owned by and held or used as the residence of a soldier, or widow or orphan of any deceased soldier, in case and to the extent that the Council deems such abatement, rebatement, or extension equitable under the circumstances.

AND WHEREAS each of the persons named in the first column of the Schedule annexed hereto has, pursuant to the said section 411, applied to the Municipal Council for abatement or rebatement of taxes.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it desirable to make such abatement or rebatement as is hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAXES ABATEMENT BY-LAW 1958."
2. The Collector is hereby authorized and directed to abate or rebate the taxes set out in the second column of the Schedule annexed hereto upon the lands and improvements more particularly described in the third column of the said

Schedule, owned by and occupied or used as the residence of the persons named in the first column of the said Schedule.
