BY-LAW NO. 4042

A BY-LAW to designate the dates on which percentage additions shall be made to unpaid taxes.

Act provides that the Municipal Council may, by by-law, designate any two or more dates on which percentage additions shall be made to unpaid taxes in respect of each parcel of land and the improvements thereon upon the real-property tax roll, and specify the percentages which may be imposed on each of such dates.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY UNPAID TAXES PENALTY BY-LAW 1959".
- 2. The Collector shall, as soon as is practicable on or after the 16th day of July in the year 1959 and in each year thereafter, add to the unpaid taxes of the current year, in respect of each parcel of land and the improvements thereon upon the real-property tax roll, five per centum of the amount unpaid as of the 16th day of July.
- 3. The Collector shall, as soon as is practicable on or after the 16th day of November in the year 1959 and in each year thereafter, add to the unpaid taxes of the current year, in respect of each parcel of land and the improvements thereon upon the real-property tax roll, five per centum of the amount unpaid as of the 16th day of November.
