BY-LAW NO. 4050

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands within the municipality and dedicate the same for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1959."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), those lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as the north ten feet of Lot 5 (except the north 130 feet thereof) of Lot 1, Blocks 4 and 7, of Lot 162, Group 1, Plan 4099, New Westminster District.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
