

BY-LAW NO. 4053

A BY-LAW to establish certain municipally-owned lands as a public highway.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is owner in fee simple of those lands hereinafter described.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to dedicate the said lands for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1959."

2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby does hereby establish as a public highway those municipally-owned lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as Block 13, District Lots 59, 136 and 137, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 3050.

3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon the registration of a certified copy thereof in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.
