

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY  
BY-LAW NO. 4056

VF 2022

A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property for highway purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and in the public interest to widen the lane lying south of Sanders Street and extending easterly from Marlborough Avenue.

AND WHEREAS for such purpose it is necessary to expropriate certain real property hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1959."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the purpose of widening the lane hereinbefore described, is hereby authorized and empowered, without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act:-
  - (a) by its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of or use the north ten feet of the east 422 feet of Block 27, of Lot 32, Group 1, Plan 812, save and except part subdivided under Plans 10045, 12272 and 14871, New Westminster District.
  - (b) by its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the said widening of the said lane for the purpose of executing any works of construction, maintenance, or repair in mitigation of injuries done or apprehended or in reduction of compensation.

3. This By-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
