BY-LAW NO. 4064

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands within
the municipality and dedicate the
same for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1959."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the north ten feet of Lot 23, of Blocks 12 and 13, District Lot 159, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1542.
3. UPON registration of the said deed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminister, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
