

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4066

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of
certain real property.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND
ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1959."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of
the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered
to acquire for highway purposes from William George
Rathie, the registered owner thereof, by a good and
sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all
encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of \$15,000.00
those lands and premises situate, lying and being in
the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia
and more particularly known and described as Lot 3, save
and except the northerly twenty feet thereof, of Block
9, District Lot 122, Group 1, New Westminster District,
Plan 1308.
3. The Municipal Council is further authorized and
empowered to acquire for school site purposes from
James A. Cooper Ltd., the registered owner thereof, by
a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and
clear of all encumbrances, those lands and premises
situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby,
Province of British Columbia, and more particularly
known and described as Lots 46, 47 and 48, of Lots 6
to 8, Block "D", of Lot 96, Group 1, New Westminster
District, Plan 1740 in consideration of the payment
of \$3,000.00 by the Company to the Municipality.
