

BY-LAW NO. 4072

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1959."
2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed of gift, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the south twenty feet of Lot 5, of Lot "C", Block 2 of Lot 38, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 18760.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
