BY-LAW NO. 4073

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISI-TION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1959."
- 2. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from Axel Bernard Wenaus, Vernon Axel Wenaus and Malcolm John Wenaus, the registered owners thereof, by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for park purposes, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the east half of Lot 3, except portion shown on Plan 15900, Block 1, of Lot 207, Group 1, Plan 4032, New Westminster District; Lots 1 and 2, except portion shown on Plan 15900, of Lots "A" and "D", Block 1, of Lot 207, Group 1, Plan 13300, New Westminster District, and to grant therefor those municipally-owned lands more particularly known and described as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, of Lot 129, Group 1, Plan 20886, New Westminster District, and the payment by the said Axel Bernard Wenaus, Vernon Axel Wenaus and Malcolm John Wenaus to the Municipality of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.
