BY-LAW NO. 4099

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands and dedicate the same for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 7, 1959."

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot 153, of Lots 2 to 7, of Lot 95, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1056,

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Lot 153, Plan 1056;

thence due west along the south boundary of said Lot 153, 25 feet;

thence north $16^{\circ} 10' 50''$ E, 23.21 feet, more or less, to a point on the northeasterly boundary of said Lot 153, situate distant 29 feet northwesterly from said southeast corner;

thence S $39^{\circ} 43' 40''$ E along said northeasterly boundary, 29 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement; all said bearings are astronomic and said parcel containing by admeasurement 279 square feet, more or less, as shown outlined in red colour on the plan annexed hereto prepared

by K. K. Wong, B. C. L. S., certified on the 17th day of November, 1959.

3. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is further authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the north ten feet of Lots 13 and 14, of Block 22, of the east half of Lot 117, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1222.

4. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands hereinbefore described shall be established as public highways.

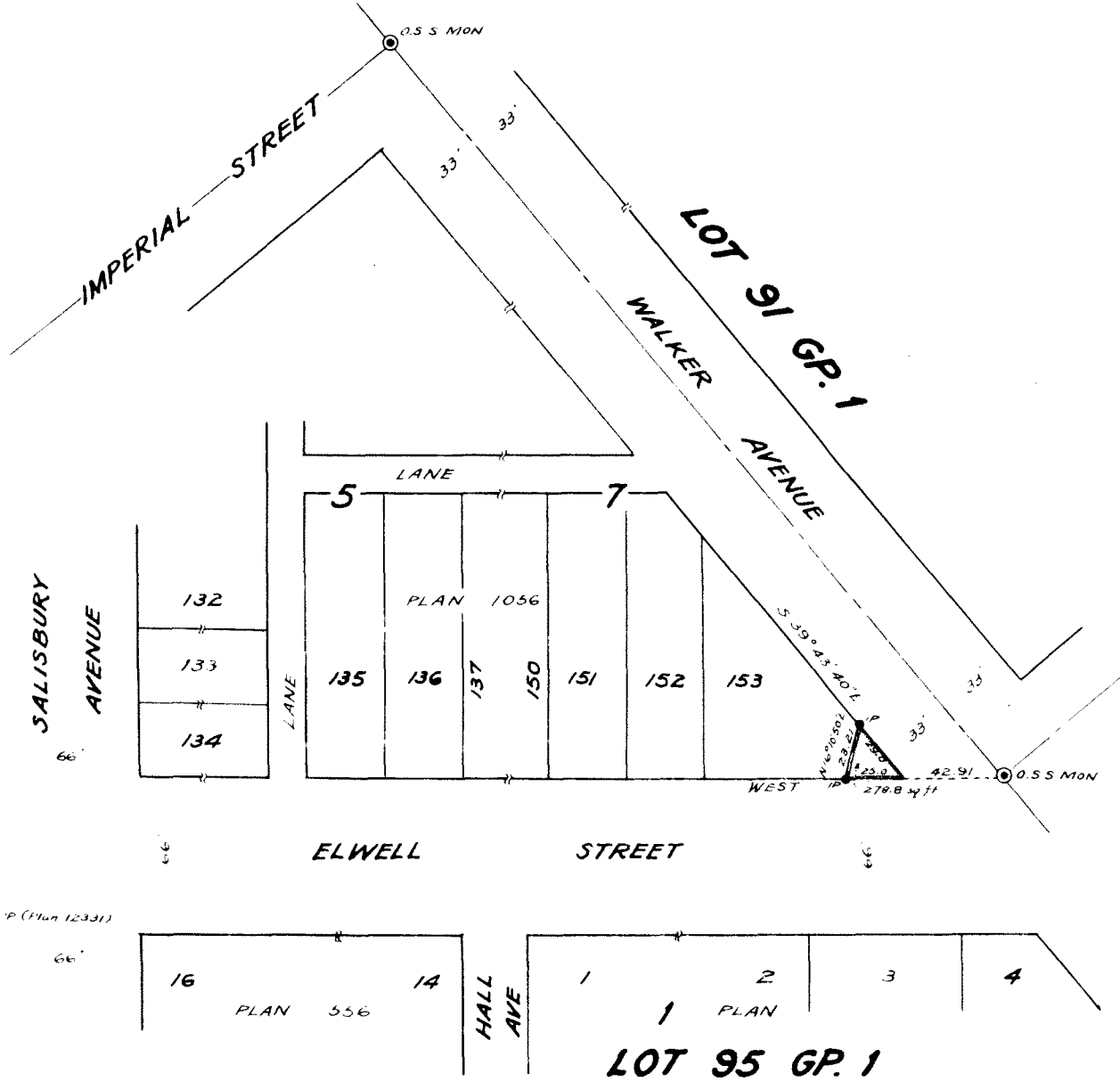
