BY-LAW NO. 4103

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain lands for highway purposes.

WHEREAS By-law No. 4056 did authorize the Council to expropriate the lands hereinafter described for highway purposes.

AND WHEREAS James Ward Milne, the registered owner in fee simple of the said lands, has granted and conveyed the same unto The Corporation of the District of Burnaby by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, in consideration of the sum of \$500.00.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1960."
2. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands herein described and known as the north ten feet of the east 422 feet of Block 27, of Lot 32, Group 1, Plan 812, save and except part subdivided under Plans 10045, 12272 and 14871, New Westminster District, shall be established as a public highway.
