THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4110

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of an asphalt pavement on Broadway in the Municipality of Burnaby as a local improvement.

WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council to undertake the construction, as a local improvement, of the work hereinafter described has been duly given by publication of the notice and by service of it upon the owners of the parcels liable to be specially charged.

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has filed a statutory declaration proving publication and service of the said notice.

AND WHEREAS no petition against the said work signed by a majority of the owners, representing at least one-half of the land value of the parcels liable to be specially charged, has been presented.

AND WHEREAS the lifetime of the said work is ten years.

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of the said work is \$5,405.00.

AND WHEREAS the share or portion of the cost of the said work which should be borne by the parcels of land which abut or are deemed to abut upon the said work is \$4,647.40.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation's share or portion of the said cost is \$757.60.

AND WHEREAS the special charges should be made payable in ten annual instalments.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1960".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to construct an asphalt pavement, twenty feet wide, on Broadway from Kensington west a distance of 1070 feet as a local improvement under the provisions of Part XVI of the Municipal Act.
- The Reeve and Clerk are authorized and empowered to cause a contract for the construction of the said work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- 4. The special charges shall be paid by ten annual instalments.
- 5. Where the number of feet of a parcel of land which abuts on the said work is more than 66 feet, the taxable foot frontage shall be 66 feet.
- 6. The Assessor shall forthwith prepare a frontagetax assessment roll in respect of the said work pursuant to section 416 of the Municipal Act and shall from time to time revise the said frontage-tax assessment roll in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section 416.
- 7. The Council may, with the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities, borrow temporarily the sum required to finance the cost of the said work pending the adoption of

a by-law under section 603 of the Municipal Act.

SCHEDULE "D"

BY-LAW NO. 4110

- 1. Pursuant to By-law No. 4110, adopted on the 15th day of February, 1960, asphaltic pavement, twenty feet wide, has been constructed on Broadway from Kensington Avenue west a distance of 1070 feet.
- 2. The total cost of constructing the pavement is \$4,037.99; the Corporation's share is \$1,232.80; the owners' share is \$2,805.19.
- 3. The estimated lifetime of the said works is ten years.
